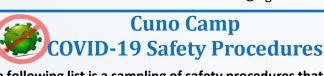

The following list is a sampling of safety procedures that we will be implementing at Cuno Camp this year.

- Screening upon Entry: Each child and staff
 member will be assessed for any visible signs of
 infection. If any child or staff member has a
 temperature over 100 degrees Fahrenheit they
 will not be permitted to attend camp that day.
- Masks: All staff members, including Junior Counselors will e required to wear a mask.
- Groups: Youth will be kept in groups of 14.
 They will practice social distancing amongst their group when possible.
- **Lunch:** Youth will be required to wash their

- hands before and after eating. Groups will eat lunch on a staggered schedule with tables sanitized in between groups.
- Equipment: All equipment will be sanitized after use.
- Additional Cleaning: Bathrooms and locker rooms will be sanitized after each group's use.
- Sick Area: If a child becomes sick during the day the child will be placed in an area away from other campers and parents will be called to come pick up the child.



Weekend Meals Program

In concert with our friends at Eli's Restaurant and the local non-profit Family Business, Inc., the Club has begun a Weekend Meals Program for our Member families who may be struggling with how to feed their kids over the summer weekends.

Club Staff will be maintaining safety protocols for this Friday program by wearing masks and getting meals to our folks with minimal contact.

The City of Meriden is providing twice daily meals to be picked up on weekdays and we're picking up Saturday and Sunday for our Member families.

The meals are prepared by Eli's and are packaged for four, and include multiple and definitely delicious courses!
