



Cell Phone Policy

Our #1 goal at the Boys and Girls Club of Meriden is to ensure the safety of all members and campers. We work very hard to ensure that there are fun and interesting activities for our campers throughout the day.

Inappropriate use of cell phones has become an issue at our Camps. Therefore, starting Monday, July 23, The Boys and Girls Club will no longer allow campers to have cell phones on their person while at either Camp. If a parent feels it is necessary for their child to bring a cell phone to Camp, the child will be required to label the phone with their name. The phone will be secured until the child is dismissed, at which time it will be returned.

If there is a reasonable need for the camper to contact their parent during the day, they should ask their Counselor who will arrange the call. If a parent needs to contact their child, they should contact the Camp at the number below. We ask parents' cooperation to only call if necessary.

If a camper is found to have a cell phone during the day, the cell phone will be temporarily confiscated, the camper will be issued a warning and the parent/guardian will be notified. If there is a second offense, the parent/guardian will be called to pick the camper up and the camper will be suspended the following day.
